Little Cheverell bridge repairs and road closure

We wanted to let you know that we'll soon be working in your area to carry out essential maintenance to Little Cheverell railway bridge on Cheverell Road, Great Cheverell. We're sorry for the late notice of this work.

Work will involve carrying out repairs to the bridge, cleaning the bridge using a method called grit blasting and painting. To assist us with these tasks, we'll need to remove some vegetation and carry out jet washing.

Due to the type of work and equipment we use, we'll need to close the road at the bridge for the majority of the time that we are working. A diversion route (a copy of the route overleaf) will be in place and signs on the road will be put out in advance. Closing a road completely is never ideal and we'll re-open the road as soon as it's safely possible.

Much of our work can be done during the day but for safety, we'll need to carry out some work overnight while trains aren't running to keep our teams safe. We've listed our planned shifts and road closures below. Please note this can change.

Lane closure with traffic lights

Monday 3 April – Tuesday 11 April	10 pm – 8 am 24 hours continuously working
Friday 14 April – Sunday 16 April	10 pm – 8 am 24 hours continuously working
Saturday 22 April – Monday 24 April	10 pm – 8 am 24 hours continuously working
Monday 1 May – Friday 12 May	9pm - 6am
