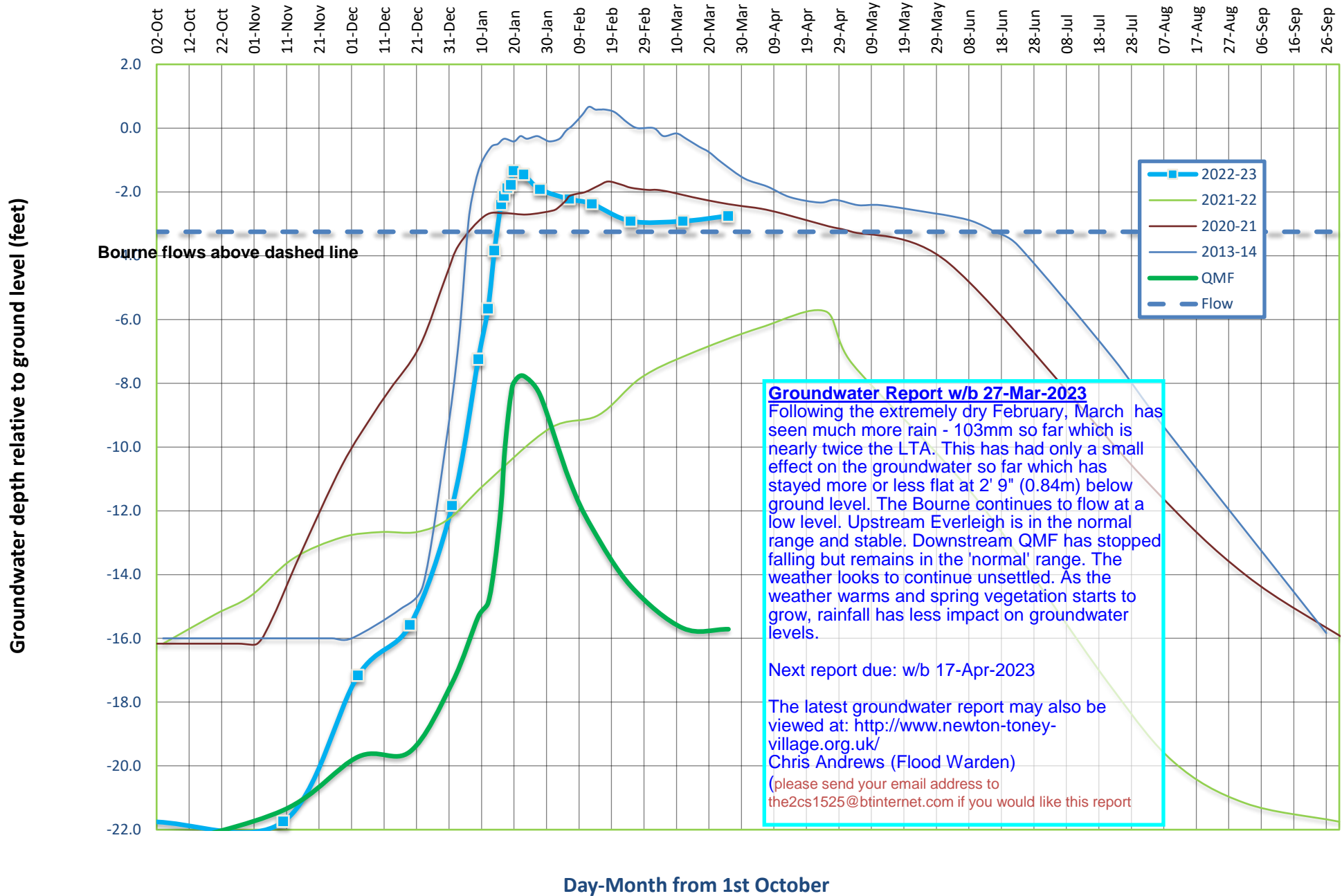


Newton Toney Groundwater Level 2022-23



Groundwater Report w/b 27-Mar-2023
 Following the extremely dry February, March has seen much more rain - 103mm so far which is nearly twice the LTA. This has had only a small effect on the groundwater so far which has stayed more or less flat at 2' 9" (0.84m) below ground level. The Bourne continues to flow at a low level. Upstream Everleigh is in the normal range and stable. Downstream QMF has stopped falling but remains in the 'normal' range. The weather looks to continue unsettled. As the weather warms and spring vegetation starts to grow, rainfall has less impact on groundwater levels.
