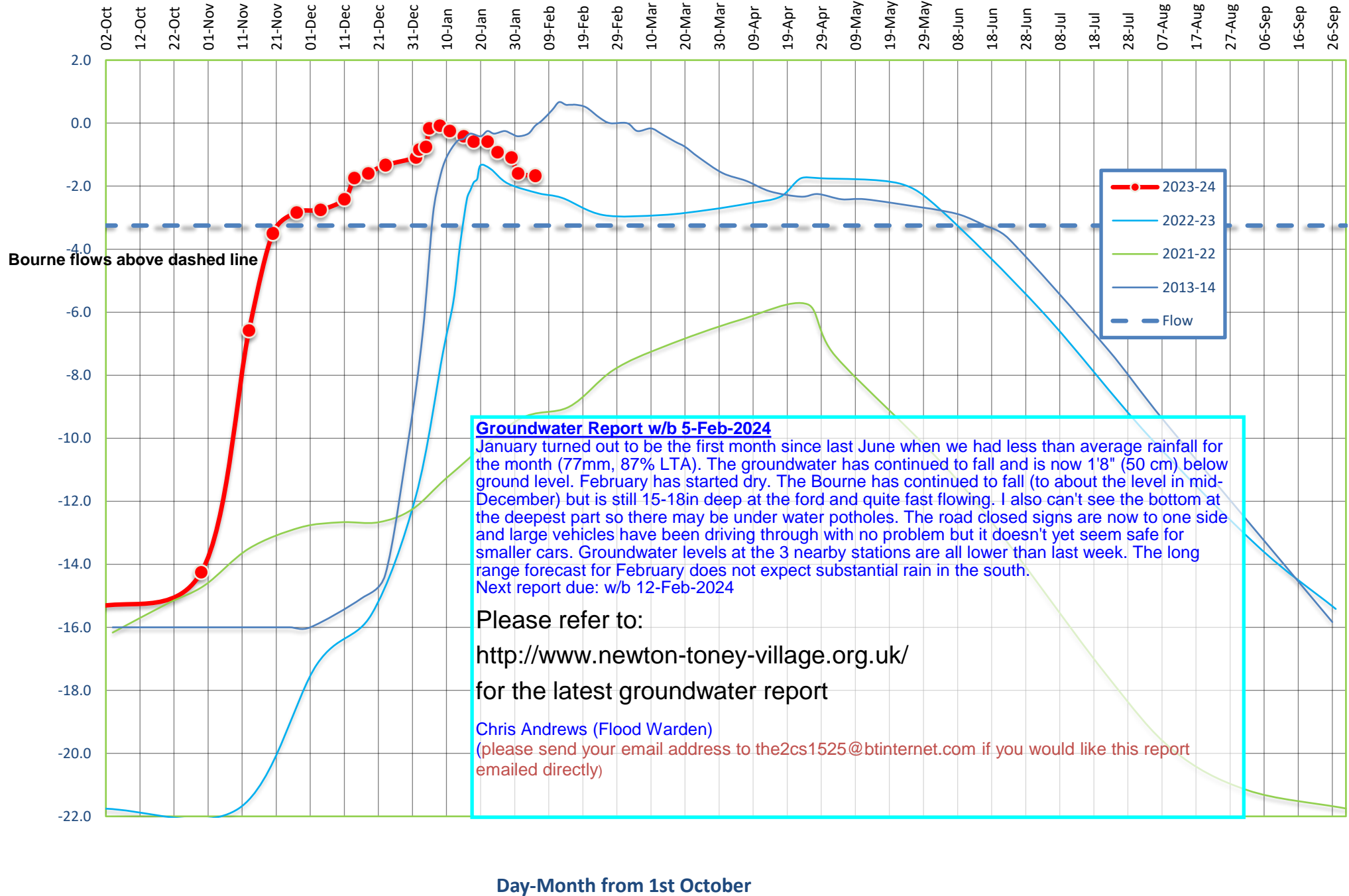


# Newton Toney Groundwater Level 2023-24

### Groundwater Report w/b 5-Feb-2024

January turned out to be the first month since last June when we had less than average rainfall for the month (77mm, 87% LTA). The groundwater has continued to fall and is now 1'8" (50 cm) below ground level. February has started dry. The Bourne has continued to fall (to about the level in mid-December) but is still 15-18in deep at the ford and quite fast flowing. I also can't see the bottom at the deepest part so there may be under water potholes. The road closed signs are now to one side and large vehicles have been driving through with no problem but it doesn't yet seem safe for smaller cars. Groundwater levels at the 3 nearby stations are all lower than last week. The long range forecast for February does not expect substantial rain in the south.
