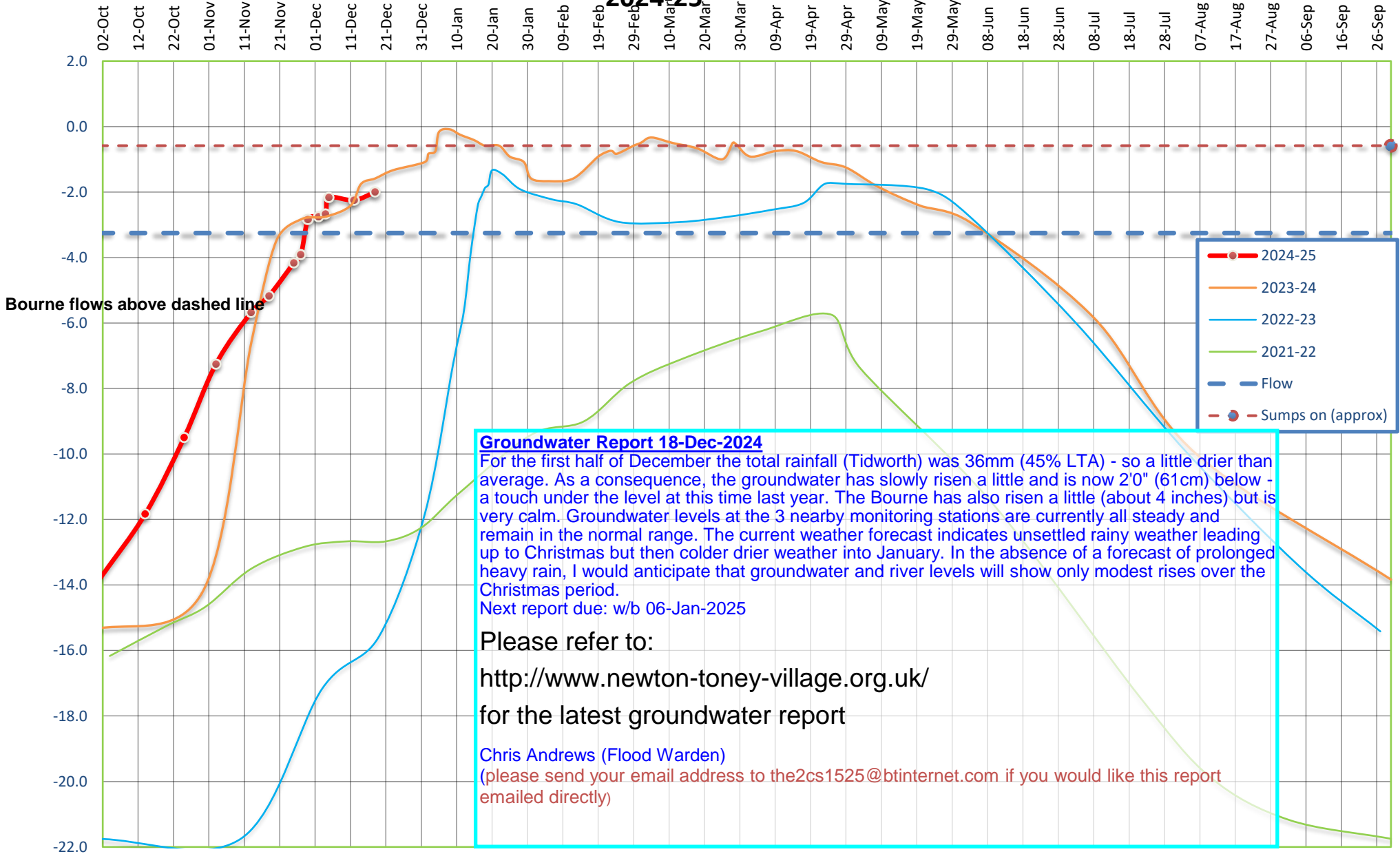


Newton Toney Groundwater Level

Groundwater Report 18-Dec-2024
 For the first half of December the total rainfall (Tidworth) was 36mm (45% LTA) - so a little drier than average. As a consequence, the groundwater has slowly risen a little and is now 2'0" (61cm) below - a touch under the level at this time last year. The Bourne has also risen a little (about 4 inches) but is very calm. Groundwater levels at the 3 nearby monitoring stations are currently all steady and remain in the normal range. The current weather forecast indicates unsettled rainy weather leading up to Christmas but then colder drier weather into January. In the absence of a forecast of prolonged heavy rain, I would anticipate that groundwater and river levels will show only modest rises over the Christmas period.
